Description:

Martinique is all we want to see in a breeding female, she has a really fine fleece which is lovely to hold and handle, a good long staple length and is beautifully fine and dense. She has correct and beautifully balanced conformation which she has inherited from her sire, EP Cambridge Courage.

Martinique is blessed in her breeding and can boast of inheriting fine pedigree genetics from both the EP Cambridge and Jolimont herds and her grand sire NWA Ltd Ruffo, a champion stud who was leader of his generation in producing superfine fleece. Her dam also brings into the mix the impressive Australian genetics of Penlan and Accoyo which makes this female something special indeed.

For 2019, Martiniques sample results showed:
