

She has a fantastic fleece that has a low Micron of 17.7 and SD of 3.9. Her fiber is bright and soft to handle with superb coverage of fleece across her body. She has a desirable, true-to-type head shape with large brown eyes and a strong muzzle. Conformationally, she is excellent with a strong stance and good substance of bone.

She is a very sweet natured, friendly girl who is easy to handle.

Bardot is due to be mated with our Stud Male (Little Nige) and this will be her first cria. Little Nige is our award-winning

solid Mid Brown Male who came 2nd in his category at the National and who has won reserve champion twice at various shows.

With her award-winning genetics, excellent fibre traits and friendly nature, Bardot would make a great addition to any herd.

All of our alpacas are halter trained, are up to date with all husbandry and if pregnant come with a live cria guarantee.
