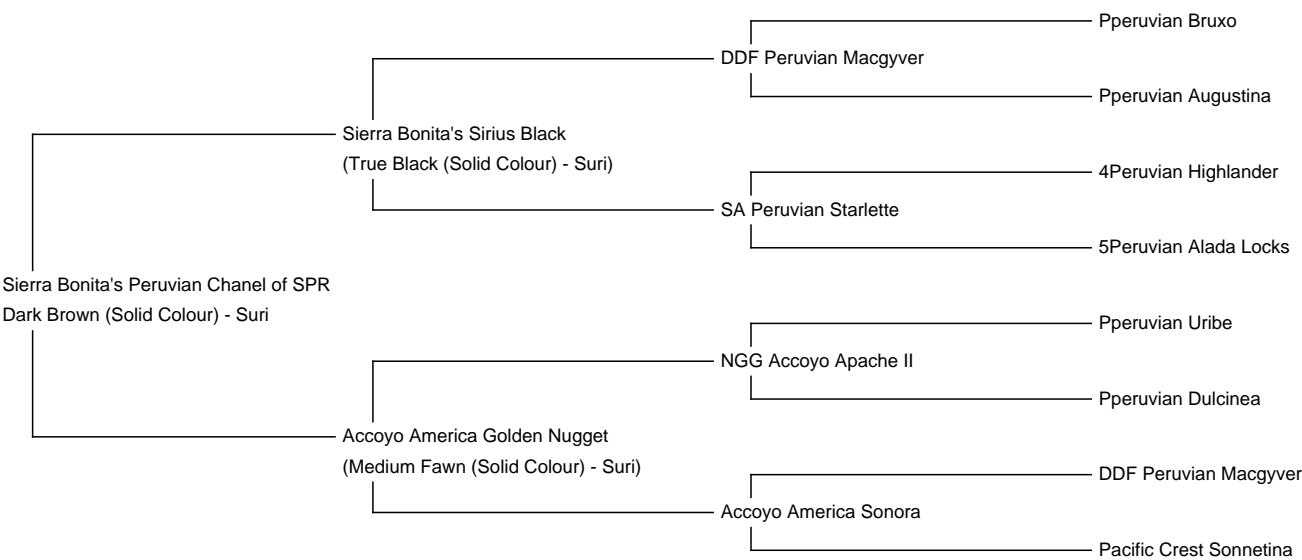

**Description:**

Described by Leslie Loveless (owner of the incredibly famous coloured Macgyver) as the best cria she had ever bred, she was selected at 6 months old. She is a smaller female which we believe was due to a tough time in quarantine - but she has been fully well the entire time she has been with us at Spring Farm. Her 2013 fibre stats were 20.24Micron, 6.4SD, 7.2CEM.

Chanel has Macgyver as her GrandSire, Sirius Black as her sire. Her Neogen tested colour coat genetics is Ee aa. She is genetically black, expressed as brown.

Every one of her crias has had impressive lustre and highly desirable fibre characteristics. They have all been at or very close to the quality that as a breeder we require in our show team. Her granddaughter - BonBon - has been retained and has produced 2 superb crias for us, both of whom are entered in the 2025 BAS National Show.

She is a quiet, unassuming, halter trained and calm alpaca to handle having had camelidynamics handling since a year of age.

Her 2024 born cria would be entered in the National Show 2025 but in this incredibly wet Winter, his fleece has become a little bit tender.

Currently not pregnant, she could be bred this year. Her price includes a free of charge breeding to one of our suri stud males.
