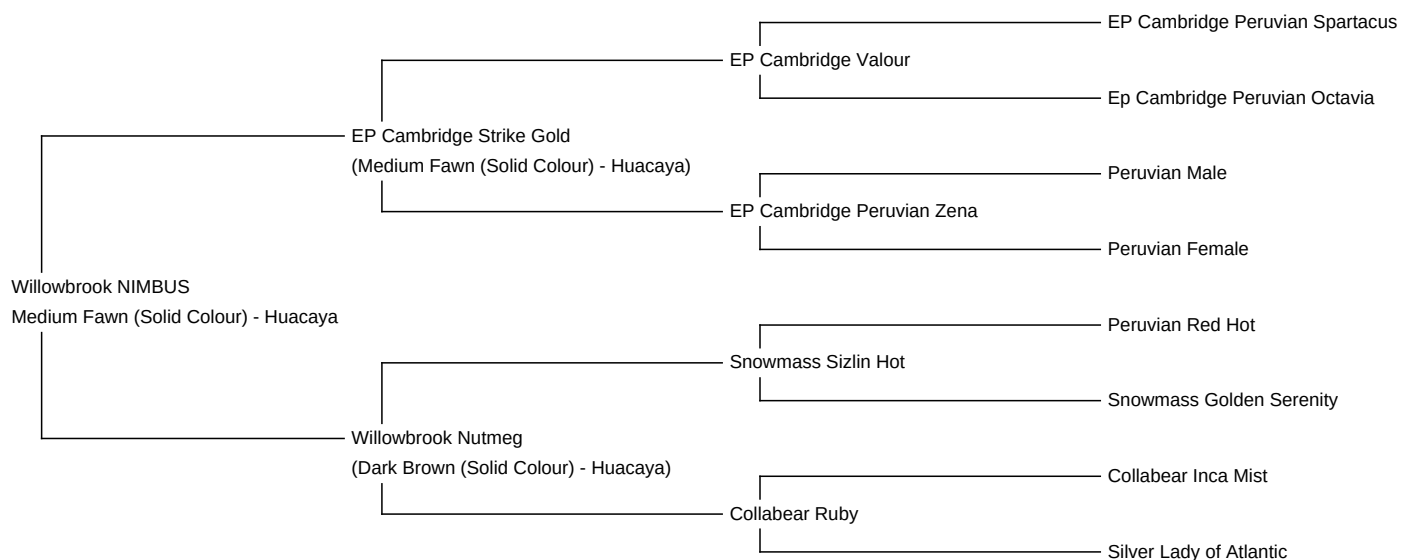

Description:

Nimbus joined our team of herdsires last year. He is a stunning male and brings a combination of highly successful Snowmass and EP Cambridge bloodlines.

Nimbus is a true golden mid fawn male. He has solid and strong bone structure and excellent balanced conformation. He is well grown for a young male. Nimbus is a very good natured and easy to handle alpaca.

Nimbus? fleece is exceptionally soft to the handle. It is fine and highly uniform, which is supported by the low S.D. and C.V. of his first and second fleece statistics. Each staple is very long and well organised with a high frequency, high amplitude crimp style that extends to the tip of each staple.

He has a excellent depth of colour and uniformity across his fleece. He has proven and highly successful bloodlines on

both sides of his pedigree. His dam (solid light brown) is a Snowmass Sizlin Hot daughter. Sizlin Hot's offspring have performed consistently well in the show ring winning many Champions and Reserve Champions in the coloured classes. Nimbus's sire is EP Cambridge Strike Gold (mid fawn), who was himself sired by EP Cambridge Valour, who in turn was sired by EP Cambridge Peruvian Spartacus (sire of Cambridge Navigator).

Nimbus has only been shown once; he was placed 5th as a junior at the North Somerset Show, in a huge and highly competitive junior fawn male class, where many entries failed to be placed!
